He leads Deloitte's specialist Valuation Group in the UK and EMEA and is a member of Deloitte's global management executive team for valuation. The Valuation Group advises on all aspects of valuing businesses, listed and unlisted securities, intellectual property and other intangible assets in the UK and internationally. He and his group provide advice and opinions in a variety of contexts including: mergers and acquisitions, corporate restructuring, corporate strategy, regulatory compliance, fairness opinions, financial reporting, tax planning, private equity and infrastructure fund portfolios, loan books, distressed debt, expert determination and contentious valuations (including valuations required for arbitration and litigation proceedings).
